The American Association of Museums (AAM) has just awarded the Sciencenter with its second AAM Museum Accreditation. Through a rigorous multi-year process of self-assessment and subsequent review by its peers, the Sciencenter has been found to meet National Standards and Best Practices for U.S. Museums and remains a member of a select community of institutions recognized for excellence, accountability, high professional standards and continued institutional improvement. Only 5% of U.S. museums have received this distinction.

The Accreditation Visiting Committee Report highlights the Sciencenter's "growth into a nationally and internationally known institution with numerous internal business lines delivering on its mission" and its "growing reputation and ability to attract strong talent from throughout the US for its leadership positions, providing the institution a remarkable strength of staff for a small institution in upstate NY."
