Toddlers, preschoolers and their caregivers are invited to enjoy a story and related activity in the Sciencenter's Curiosity Corner at 10:30 a.m. every Tuesday. **Curiosity Corner programs** are included with admission, and children under 3 are always free.

The **Discovery Space** at the Sciencenter is a quiet area for children to explore the world of science through activity kits and games. Guests can experiment with topics such as fingerprinting, magnification, water and more. These discovery boxes are geared to a variety of ages. Check the open hours with our front desk.

From noon to 5 p.m. on **Veterans Day**, this Sunday, and the observed holiday on Monday, November 12, 10 a.m.– 5 p.m., admission to the Sciencenter is free for veterans, active duty military personnel and their immediate families. Just show a valid military ID at the front desk.
