From Here to There, a new exhibit on movement, debuts at the Ithaca Sciencecenter on Saturday, Sept. 17.

The science of movement, whether on land, under the water or in the air, is the focus of a new interactive exhibit that launches Saturday, Sept. 17 at the Sciencenter in Ithaca.

The From Here to There exhibit features 12 interactive stations that provide hands-on learning about concepts such as gravity, friction and the laws of motion.

“Each exhibit is designed to spark conversation and encourage interaction among families, friends, and other museum guests,” said Amy Gaulke, museum public and media relations manager, in a press release.

A hoverboard chair, hot air balloon and canal locks are a few of the interactive exhibits that make up the new offering.
