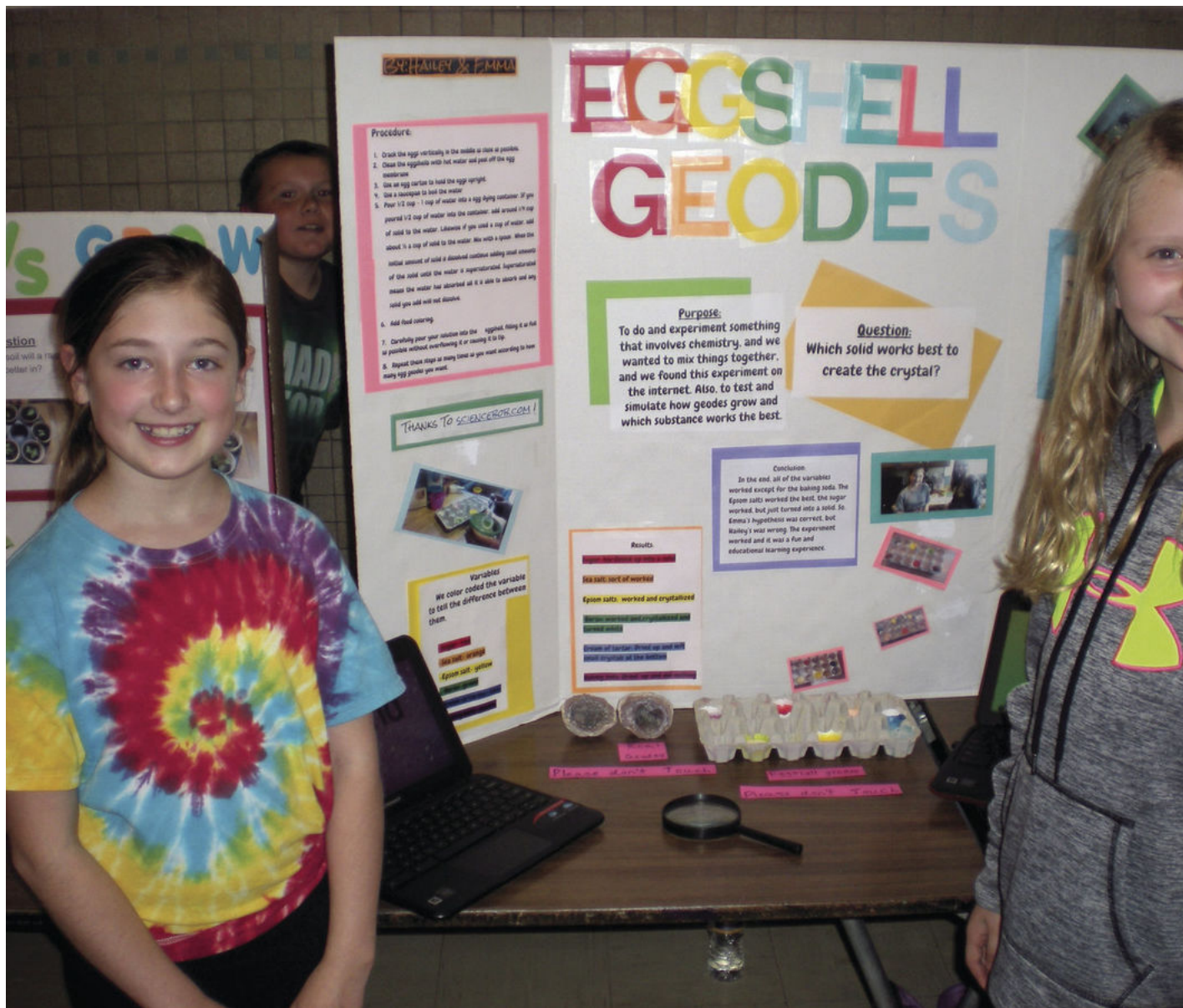

ROMULUS — Romulus Elementary School celebrated science week May 16-20.

During that week, students were exposed to different aspects of the science field and each class worked on a project.

The Ithaca Science Center brought its Star Lab for the day so students could get a good look at the constellations, and families were encouraged to bring in projects made from recycled products.

The sixth-grade students gave other classrooms lessons on composting and gardening. A kindergarten room became a petting zoo as students got to meet a baby pig, a baby goat and baby chicks.

On May 19, students participated in a Science Fair. Families were invited to attend and more than 100 people came out to see the projects. Josiah Torres came in third place with his brushbot. Some of the sixth-grade students placed second with their project on the pH levels of the compost made at the school.
