WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE FIELD TRIP

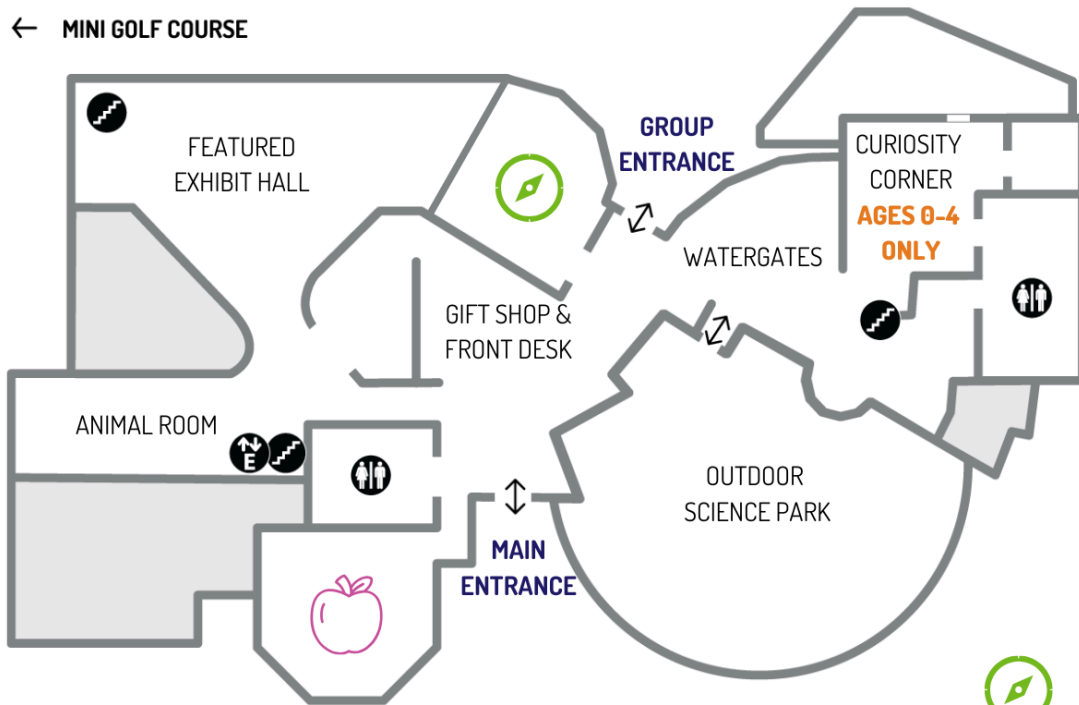
Your field trip will have three main parts:

- **Self-Guided Museum Exploration:** You will spend most of your time exploring the museum in a small group. During this time, please keep the following in mind:
 - **School rules apply here.** Please remind students to use **calm bodies** and **indoor voices** and to **be respectful of others** in the museum (use exhibits safely, be aware of their surroundings, share materials with others, etc.).
 - **The museum is one big loop.** We recommend spreading out from other groups so that exhibits don't get overcrowded and traveling in the same direction to ensure that you see everything.
 - **Curiosity Corner is off limits** because it's designed for ages 0-4. Please help us keep our youngest explorers safe and comfortable by exploring other areas instead!
- **Engineering Workshop:** Your group will be assigned a time to participate in the workshop portion of your visit, which takes place in the Classroom on the second floor. Please do your best to arrive promptly for your program slot.
- **Lunch:** Lunches will be stowed on a cart in the Community Room, and will be waiting for you when you arrive at your assigned lunch time. Please do not eat in any other areas of the museum.

Most importantly, remember to HAVE FUN and enjoy exploring the Sciencenter with your child and their friends!
